Mark 15:40-47

We are delayed but not denied from receiving a blessing.

Jesus Buried in Joseph's Tomb

There's more women than men now, as it was then, around Jesus.

Be careful how you start a thing. You may finish it the same way.

John 19:31-37

During crucifixion, the legs were broken that those hanging could not use them to hold themselves up to get air.

Jesus was already dead when the soldiers came to check on Him.

The women were watching what happened, which is why they knew where Jesus was the next morning.

Mark 16:1-8 (He is Risen)

(Matthew 12:39-40)

Jesus was in the ground 3 days and 3 nights... it's a study point, not a salvation point.

(Luke 23:54-56)

Mark said they had spices after the Sabbath. Luke says they had the spices and rested on the Sabbath.

(John 19:31)
